YOUTH CLUB (VOLUNTEER) APPLICATION FORM - RULES, GUIDELINES AND TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. APPLICATION FORM

- Only children of current paid IRCC members are eligible to apply to be youth club members and volunteers at IRCC events.
- Applicants must be in middle or high school.
- All forms should be submitted online. Forms are available on the IRCC website on the Registration Forms page. Upon online form submission, a confirmation email will be sent to the email address provided in the form. If you do not receive any email, then please contact IRCC Youth Club coordinators via e-mail (youthclub@ircclorida.org). The form must be completed in full.
- If you submit an application form and do not meet the eligibility criteria of being a paid IRCC member, or do not meet any other above-mentioned criteria, your application to be an IRCC youth club member or volunteer will be denied.

2. GENERAL TERMS

- By submitting the form online, the applicant and the applicant's parent agree to abide by all guidelines, rules, terms, and conditions specified in this document and on the IRCC website, to be eligible to continue to be a youth club member or volunteer at IRCC events.
- By submitting this form, participants and their parents or legal guardians hereby grant permission to IRCC permission for the use of their likeness in photographs, videos, or other digital media in any and all of its publications, including web-based publications, without any financial obligation of payment or any other consideration from IRCC.

3. REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF APPLICATION

- The IRCC Board will review all submissions and approve or deny the submission. The IRCC Board reserves the right to accept or decline a youth club membership/volunteer application.

4. RULES

- When a youth club co-ordinator or IRCC Board member contacts you for your availability to volunteer, we expect a response within a reasonable amount of time.
- Once you have committed to volunteering at an event, you must show up on time and perform the activities assigned to you.
- Volunteers may receive community service hours for their schools, if they bring the community service form to the volunteering opportunity and get it signed on the spot by the youth club co-ordinator.
- In case of any dispute that may arise, IRCC Board reserves the right to review and finalize decisions related to youth club (membership and volunteer) enrollment applications, especially in the case of any dispute that may arise.
- Any and all matters not expressly provided for in this document or on the IRCC website will be resolved at the sole discretion of IRCC.
