## ANAND BAZAAR – VENDOR PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT - RULES, GUIDELINES AND TERMS AND CONDITIONS

### 1. APPLICATION FORM

- This event is only for IRCC members and their families. Restaurants and commercial vendors are not allowed to participate in this event.
- Only IRCC members may submit application forms to participate in this event as a vendor.
- All vendors must complete the application form by the deadline specified in the online form.
- All forms should be submitted online. Forms are available on the IRCC website on the Registration Forms page. Upon online form submission, a confirmation email will be sent to the email address provided in the form. If you do not receive any email, then please contact IRCC Vendor Committee via e-mail ([vendor@irccflorida.org](mailto:vendor@irccflorida.org)). The form must be completed in full, and payment submitted online.
- The vendor application fee is non-refundable. However, the full amount of the fees will be refunded if IRCC cancels the event.
- If you submit an application form and are not eligible to do so, either as a non-IRCC-member or a commercial vendor or restaurant, please note that your application will be denied, and your application fee will not be refunded.
- No rainchecks will be issued in case of any bad weather on the day of the event.

### 2. GENERAL TERMS

- By submitting the form online and making the payment for table(s), the vendor agrees to abide by all guidelines, rules, terms, and conditions specified in this document and on the IRCC website. The vendor also agrees that the contact person submitting the form on the IRCC website has the authority to bind the vendor into this agreement with IRCC.

### 3. REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF APPLICATION

- The IRCC Board will review all submissions and approve or deny the submission. The IRCC Board will have exclusive authority to determine whether to accept a vendor application, and to approve or deny exceptions, if any.

### 4. SETUP TIME AND PRICING INFORMATION

- The event is usually held on or around the last Sunday of January. The venue is usually a local park in Broward County, Florida. Confirmed details of date and venue can be found on the IRCC website.
- Time of event: 11:00 am to 4:00 pm
- Setup time: 10:00 am to 11:00 am on the day of event.
- Setup must be completed by 11:00 am.

### 5. COST AND ITEM PRICING INFORMATION

- All vendors must charge a fair price for their food items and provide those details on their application. If necessary, our Board will make requests to adjust prices in the best interests of everyone involved.
- Vendor must pay IRCC a fee to be able to participate in the event. The fees will differ for selling 1 item, 2 items, 3 items, etc. This information can be found on the IRCC website and on the vendor application form.
- A vendor may sell no more than 3 items.

## 6. RULES

- Vendor is responsible for bringing their own table, chairs and equipment. The table size should not exceed 6 ft. in length.
- No electricity will be provided. Vendors must make their own arrangements for cooking or heating the food.
- Vendors must bring sufficient paper goods – paper cups, paper plates, napkins, paper bowls and plastic cutlery - to serve their items.
- Vendor staff are required to always use gloves while handling food. They should also ensure that they bring a sufficient supply of clean gloves.
- All vendor staff should wear face masks.
- Vendors must bring sufficient cash in small denominations to be able to provide change to buyers. Vendors may also accept payment via credit cards, Zelle, Venmo, etc. as long as they have enough attendants to manage these forms of payment and not cause long waits.
- Only vegetarian items are permitted to be served.
- No vendors are permitted to sell pizza, water bottles or national brand sodas. Vendors may sell Indian vegetarian food items or soft drinks like lassi, khatta meetha, jaljira, sorbets, milk shakes and ethnic juices.
- Vendors should keep their area clean and tidy at all times. IRCC may charge an additional amount to vendors if IRCC incurs additional cleaning expenses to clean the vendor's booth area or if IRCC incurs any fines/penalties due to the negligence of the vendor.
- Vendor table(s) will be confirmed only after receipt of payment.
- Vendors are not allowed to use any kind of public address or audio system including speakers, microphones, etc.
- Exhibits must be arranged in such a way so as to not block or interfere with any other vendor's exhibits or any of IRCC's exhibits.
- IRCC reserves the right to confiscate any and all property of vendors who have violated any of the above rules or provisions or who refuse to leave the venue in the event of expulsion.
- IRCC reserves the right to forfeit any rented vendor's space that remains unoccupied on the event day by 11:00 am or on failure to make proper payment. IRCC may at its discretion provide the said space to any other vendor, or to use the said space in any other manner.

## 7. LIABILITY

- Vendor is solely responsible for protection and security of its equipment, supplies, goods, or other property. Vendor hereby releases, holds harmless and agrees to indemnify IRCC, its officers, directors, representatives, employees, and agents from any loss of damage whatsoever to vendor property.
- Vendor is solely and exclusively responsible for any and all risks, claims, losses, damages or causes of action whatsoever arising from Vendor's participation at this event.
- Vendor hereby releases and waives any and all claims for personal injury, product liability, theft, breakage, or any other damage, against IRCC, the event venue and Broward County.
- Your entry and presence on the event premises constitute your consent to be photographed, filmed, and/or otherwise recorded and to the release, publication, exhibition, or reproduction of any and all recorded media of your appearance, voice, and name for any purpose whatsoever in perpetuity in connection with IRCC and its initiatives, including, by way of example only, use on websites, in social media, news and advertising.
- IRCC shall not be liable for failure to perform its obligations under this contract as a result of strikes, riots, acts of God, terrorism, or any other cause beyond its control.
- Any and all matters not expressly provided for in this document or on the IRCC website will be at the sole discretion of IRCC.
